Select the Right Room Air Conditioner.

Bigger isn't always cooler. That's especially true when you select a room air conditioner. Operating an air conditioning unit that is too large for a room wastes energy because it's less effective at removing humidity from the air. That's why it's important to select the right unit to fit your needs.

Room air conditioner sizes are rated in BTUs (British Thermal Units) per hour. The chart below will help you choose a room air conditioner size that's right for you.

Room size (sq.ft.)	Room Air Conditioner Size (BTUs per hour)
100 - 150	5,000
150 - 250	6,000
250 - 300	7,000
300 - 350	8,000
350 - 400	9,000
400 - 450	10,000
450 - 550	12,000
550 - 700	14,000
700 - 1000	18,000

Typically the smallest room air conditioner available is 5000 BTUs per hour.

Other factors to consider in properly sizing a room air conditioner

- If the room is very sunny, increase the size by 10%. If it is very shady, decrease the size by 10%.
- If more than two people regularly occupy the room, add 600 BTUs per hour for each additional person to the size selected.
- If your room air conditioner is intended for use in a kitchen, increase size by 4,000 BTUs per hour.
- The factors listed above will provide you with general information for sizing a room air conditioner in Vermont. There may be other factors not considered here that could affect the size of the room air conditioner you choose. Check with a sales associate or a qualified cooling professional to make sure you are choosing the appropriate size for your needs.

These select ENERGY STAR® room air conditioners are eligible for a \$40 mail-in rebate and have met the Consortium for Energy Efficiency's (CEE) Tier 1 specifications.
